So, if we are *Filled* with...

- Sorrow, John 16:6
- Confusion, <u>Acts 19:29</u>
- Fear, Luke 5:26*; Heb.2:15
- Jealousy, <u>Acts 5:17</u>; <u>13:45</u>
- Rage, Luke 4:28; 6:11; Acts 19:28
- All Unrighteousness, <u>Rom.1:29</u>
- Satan, <u>Acts 5:3</u>

This Year's Theme is *"Letting Christ Dwell in Your Hearts,"* <u>Eph.3:14-21</u> But He can't do so if there's no room! Even Jesus *"emptied Himself,"* <u>Phil.2:7</u>; <u>cf. Col.3:5-11</u>.

There's no room to be *filled* with...

- ✓ Joy, <u>2Tim.1:4;</u> <u>Acts 13:52</u>
- ✓ Knowledge, <u>Rom.15:14</u> (Col.1:9)
- ✓ Comfort, <u>2Cor.7:4</u>
- ✓ Wonder & Amazement, <u>Acts 3:10</u>
- ✓ Peace, <u>Rom.15:13</u>
- ✓ Fruit of Righteousness, <u>Phil.1:11</u>
- ✓ Him who Fills All in All, <u>Eph.1:23; 3:19</u>

Thus, we're back to where we began: Jesus, and joy, knowledge, comfort, wonder/amazement, peace, and the fruit of righteousness, can't "dwell in (and fill) our hearts" unless we're will to make room by cleaning/clearing out sorrow, confusion, fear, jealousy, rage, all unrighteousness, and Satan! DO YOU need emptying so you can be filled?
